## REPORT BY SPECIAL FIDUCIARY TRACI M. CHRISTIAN

Pursuant to the appointment of Traci M. Christian as Special Fiduciary of the Singing River Health System Employees' Retirement Plan and Trust (the "Plan"), the Court has requested a monthly report. The Special Fiduciary brings to the Court's attention the following items for the month of January, 2019.

## Update - Transition of Investment Management and Custodial Services

Certain classes of the Plan's investments are in the process of moving to Fifth Third Bank for custodial services and will be managed by FCI Advisors under the guidance of Fiduciary Vest. The target date for the transition of assets was January 10. Some assets are still in transition but no disruption of service is expected. Fifth Third will begin making benefit payments to retirees and other payees of the Plan on February 1, 2019.
